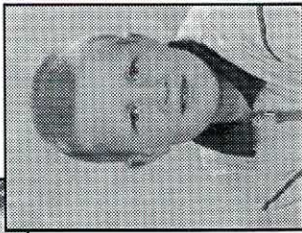
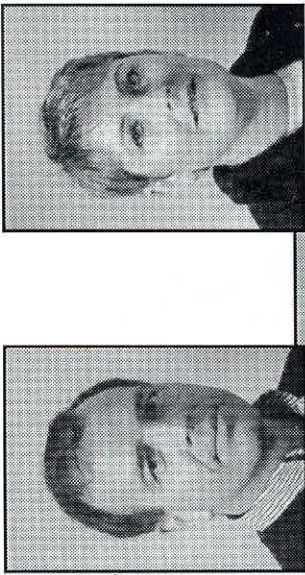

I wish everybody a very good, delightful and remarkable "Iustrum-celebration" that will be in our minds forever.

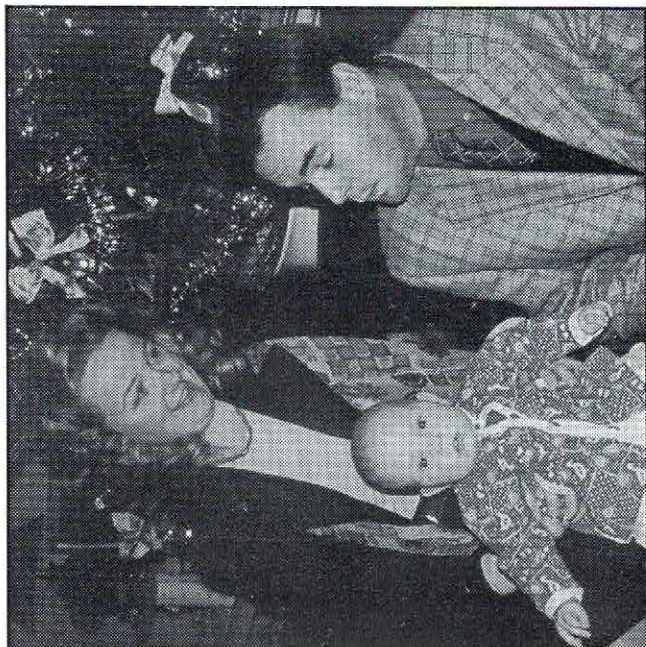
