


Conference 2022 will feature spectacular venues for our magical events, fabulous fellowship and friendship and a lot of full.

## **National Walking Weekend 2022**

#### 1st - 3rd July 2022 : Oakwood Hall Hotel, Bingley

Shipley 41 Club

Following the great success of this year's inaugural National Walking weekend held in Pembrokeshire that attracted more than 40 enthusiastic walkers. I am delighted to inform you that the 2022 National Walking weekend will be held in "God's own" Yorkshire. The event will take place on the weekend of the 1st to 3rd of July 2022.

Our base Hotel will be the historic Oakwood Hall Hotel in Bingley, where we have secured favourable rates for the weekend. If the demand is sufficient we will be able to use an overflow Hotel which is less than 200 yards from our base.

There are several walks available to us from a gentle 4 mile walk along the Leeds Liverpool canal, passing by famous Five Rise locks and proceeding to the village of Saltaire, a world heritage site, where walkers can spend some post walk time exploring the village and learning it's history along with enjoying some refreshments in the many establishments available.

For the slightly more enthusiastic, we have a gentle 8 mile walk along the canal from Apperley Bridge to Saltaire, via the village of Esholt, the village of Emmerdale in the TV series. We plan to meet up with the 4 mile walkers in Saltaire to enjoy lunch and/or other refreshments.

For the more ambitious walkers the afternoon walk will be a "yomp" over Baildon Moors to enjoy some fantastic scenery and to get your heart pumping, returning to the Hotel for Tea and scones in the late afternoon.

Similarly to the event in Pembrokeshire, for those arriving on Thursday evening, A trip to a local restaurant will be organised and on Friday we will have a 6 mile riverside loop walk from Grassington to Burnsall. Walkers may then spend time exploring Grassington or travel to the nearby town of Ilkley for a stroll around the shops. A short walk will be arranged on Sunday morning with a suitable venue to be found to enjoy lunch.

Accommodation can be arranged for those who wish to stay an extra night on the Thursday or Sunday.





### An article from the Algarve Archives

This year we tried to be different - instead of just re-calling Club memories we thought it would be a better idea to CREATE a new memory ...

- like many Clubs our activities have been limited for too long, but we never forget the Community Service need that we all learned in RT .... SO from our Archive material, we revived our historic support for the Children's Orphanage here in Lagos on the Western Algarve

# WHISKY CORNER KON'NICHIWAL

Whilst most of you will be aware that Japan traditionally known for Saki, a rice wine, Japanese whisky is much older than people often realise, with the first malt distillery producing spirit as far back as 1923.

Where there once only one or two distilleries, Japanese whisky has expanded and been more creative within a new era of whisky making. Just look at the map of Japanese distilleries!

There were two 'founding fathers' of Japanese whiskies:

**Shinjiro Torii** – who established the Suntory brand and the first distillery Yamazaki in a suburb of Kyoto in 1923. Part of the distillery was built on the site of a former temple which shrine in whichthere are always two casks of maturing whisky placed there as an offerings to the gods!



Torii employed **MasatakaTaketsuru** as a distillery executive, who had spent many years in Scotland studying and learning the art of distilling there, brought his skills back to Japan in the 20s and went on to found Yoichi on Hokkaido eleven years later.

The typical style and character of Japanese whisky includes honeysuckle, orange, acetone and toffee and I would strongly recommend members trying – the three whiskies below are ones that have been tasted within my Club's Whisky Club, the WACWAC and were all very much enjoyed!

#### Hatozaki Pure Malt

Non-aged-statement (NAS) ABV 46% - cost around £47

Named after the oldest stone lighthouse in Japan from a distillery that stands along the coast of the Seto inland sea.

A product of 100% malt whiskies which have been blended with 5 to 6-year-old single malts. The blend is then further aged in ex bourbon casks, ex sherry casks and Japanese Mizunara casks from the Hokkaido and Tohuku forests. It is only produced in small batches of less than 20 casks with no colouring or chill-filtering.

**Colour** – Pale straw

**Nose** - Dried fruit, sweet malt, a drizzle of honey, aromatic incense and sandalwood

**Palate** - Rich and complex with a good helping of malt, aromatic spices, dried fruit and toasted cereal notes, with a slightly creamy vanilla undertone

Finish - Delicately smoky and sweet honey on the finish, with lingering cigar box





#### **Tokinoka Black Blended Whisky**

It is NAS, is ABV 50% and costs around £48 for 50cl.

This whisky is from the White Oak distillery, located in Akashi near the town of Kobe.

This whisky is a mix of 50% malt whisky and 50% grain whisky that has been aged in three different types of cask – ex-bourbon, sherry and virgin oak casks

Colour - Deep Amber

Nose- Citrus fruits, dried apricots and floral honey

Palate - Creamy vanilla, exotic fruit and toasted oak with prickles of sweet spice

Finish - An elegant, medium length finish

#### **Akashi Single Malt**

Akashi Single Malt Whisky is 46% ABV and costs around £74 for a 50cl bottle

It's also from the White Oak distillery, which also produces Sake rice wine. The area's large annual swings in temperature results in faster maturation.

It is small family-run distillery – only 40k litres p.a.

This whisky uses Scottish lightly peated barley which is aged in two different types of casks – Ex-Bourbon 3 years, Ex-Sherry for 2 years

Colour: Pale Gold

**Nose**: Sherry, sweet, baked apple, slight prune

Palate: Cream, slight smoke, smooth, mellow, strong oak, vanilla, honey

Finish: Soft, smooth texture, port-like, very faint dark chocolate
